

## **DENTAL CARE PROFESSIONALS REGISTRATION**

As you are aware registration for dental care professionals begins in July 2006.

There is a transitional period of 2 years (until June 2008) to give dental technicians time to register. This transitional period is not available to potential clinical dental technicians.

To become a registered clinical dental technician you must first register as a dental technician and then register with the clinical dental technician qualification which you are currently undertaking.

Because of this requirement George Brown College requires evidence that you are a qualified dental technician. At present the only way to achieve this is to register with the Dental Technicians Association Voluntary Register which will give you automatic registration when you apply to the General Dental Council later this year.

Those students currently registered for the George Brown College Course will now need to apply to the Dental Technicians Association for registration.

Once you have completed this process you will need to forward a copy of your registration certificate to this office for onward transmission to George Brown College.
